An easy smile and delightful sense of humor are part of Gaye's relaxed, pleasant style while calling and teaching. Gaye calls contra dances throughout the U.S. and Canada.

### Coffee Zombies

From Louisville, KY, Tom Cunningham brings his swing, old-time and bluegrass influences to the fiddle and guitar. Drawing on her passion for Roma gypsy, Celtic and Balkan dance music, Dianna Davis brings her keyboard, accordion, clarinet and foot percussion playing from Indianapolis, IN. Playing percussion and guitar, Louisville's Bob Douglas infuses the band with years of experience in world beat, punk and prog rock. The Coffee Zombies' sound incorporates original tunes based on rock, classical and folk styles, as well as traditional and modern dance tunes. Combined with their hard-driving rhythmic base, their sound makes everyone want to dance.

### Dugan Murphy

Dugan currently lives in Skowhegan, Maine where he calls regularly in northern New England and co-edits a monthly newsletter for the Down East Friends of the Folk Arts (DEFFA). He enunciates with a smooth radio voice, speaking only as much as necessary to get dancers moving. His repertoire of dances is focused on zesty, modern, symmetrical contra choreography.
